## **FBMS: After School Enrichment Program - General Information**

- **CLASSES START:** Monday, March 1, 2010 or Wednesday, March 3, 2010
  - **Time:** Classes begin immediately after school and end at 3:25pm.
- **DURATION:** Classes meet for six weeks from March 1 to April 12<sup>th</sup>. *No classes will be held the week of March 22 due to the school play.* If a class is canceled for any reason, the make-up class will be held during the week April 26<sup>th</sup>.
- **TUITION: \$50.00 PER COURSE** – Snack included
  - **Please make check or money order, no cash, payable to: Town of Marshfield, please write in the memo – FBMS: ASEP.**
  - **Note:** *If you have 2 or more children participating, please fill-out one application per child but you may send in one check for all. Please send in all the applications and check with one child.*
  - **Payment in full is expected with the application. However if there is a financial concern please contact the Program Director as soon as possible. If needed, arrangements can be made so your child will be able to participate.**
  - \$25.00 of your tuition is non-refundable. If your child is unable to attend the program for any reason, please submit a written request, **before March 1st**, to receive a refund of the remainder of the tuition. The written request should be sent to the Program Director, Mrs. Vidito. After the first class meeting, no refunds will be made.
  - **DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION – Friday, February 12, 2010**
- **COURSE PLACEMENT:** Students are placed in courses on a first-come, first-serve basis. If we cannot place your child in their first choice, he/she will be placed in their second or third choice as indicated.
- **COURSE NOTIFICATION:** Course Rosters will be posted in main lobby by February 23rd.
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Parent/Guardian Pick-up is preferred but late buses will be available
  - **Parent Pick-up is at the side of the building.**
  - All students are expected to go directly home following dismissal before joining friends for other activities.
- **LEAVING A COURSE EARLY:** If a student is going to be dismissed before 3:25pm, a written note needs to be provided to the course instructor or program director prior to or at the beginning of the class. Students will not be allowed to leave before 3:25pm without a written note, or a parent/guardian coming to the main office to dismiss them.
- **STUDENT BEHAVIOR:** All school rules will apply during the program. Any student who is unable to participate in an appropriate manner will be removed from the course. In addition, they will be unable to attend the remainder of the classes and will not be issued any refund.

### **SEWING ACCESSORIES**

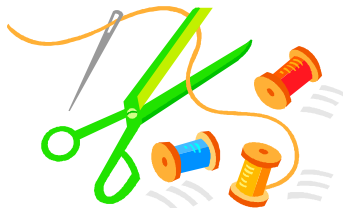
