Thank you to all the parents and guardians who participated in Curriculum Night. Mr. Dunn and I spoke about Social Emotional Learning (SEL) and that it is a focus for our school and district. Our theme for the year is "Celebrate What's Right about Martinson". I am celebrating our amazing students and staff. MCAS results were sent home last Thursday for grades 4 and 5. Last year 43% of MES 4th graders received "Exceeded Expectations" ELA. Out of the 936 elementary schools in Massachusetts, our 4th graders are #4 in the state. That is something to celebrate!
