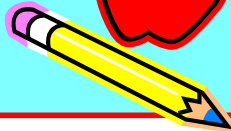
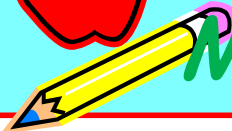

PLEASE NOTE: If you are planning on helping in either the classroom or on Field Trips you must make sure your Cori is up to date as of this fall. Everyone must be recored.

Nurses Corner

If your child has an illness such as fever, respiratory, GI, strep throat, or bacterial conjunctivitis please observe the return to school policy - which states that students should be free of symptoms for at least 24 hours- without the use of OTC remedies such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen for fever. Please call the school Health Office if you have any concerns or questions about illnesses and health policies. A written note of documentation must be presented to the school following any absences. Any absence/illness lasting 3 or more days must have a physician's note of medical clearance upon returning to school.

Any medication that is to be stored or administered at school- must be accompanied by a Dr.'s written order with indications for use.

State Mandated Vision and Hearing Screenings have begun in the health office. Please call Nurse Mudge at 781-319-3985 if you have any questions about the process.
