Nurses Corner

If your child is in the fourth grade and you have not done so already- please forward a copy of this year's physical exam (2017-2018).

Students have been reminded to take good care of their health by staying hydrated (avoid sugary drinks), brush and floss their teeth, choose snacks that are healthy such as fruits and vegetables, and get plenty of rest- especially with the time change this weekend. Fatigue often causes students to not feel well during the school day, and can contribute to belly aches and headaches.
