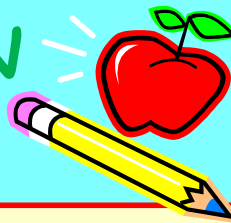

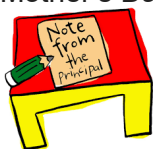

## Nurses Corner

There has been a significant increase in the incidences of strep throat throughout the building. Symptoms of strep vary and may also include other signs such as headache, rashes, GI issues, nausea and/or stomach aches. In addition to throat discomfort.

As with any contagious illness, please keep your child home, for at least 24 hours of receiving antibiotics and longer if symptoms are present that make them not feel well during the illness, to prevent spreading germs to other people in the building. They must be fever free, without the use of Acetaminophen(Tylenol) and/or Ibuprofen(Advil/Motrin).

Please notify the school, front office, for absences and/or the Nurse for illnesses that are contagious. Please provide a written note for the teacher upon returning to school.
