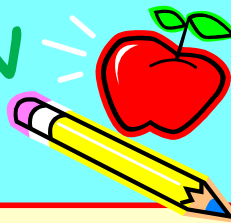

and tied for 5th place are Torianna Spry and Travis Thayer (50)

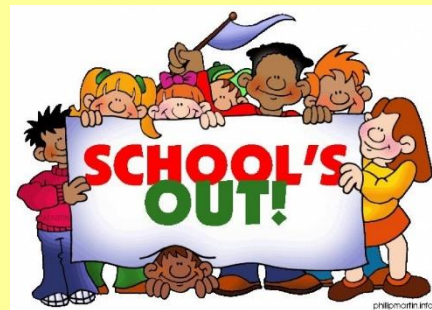
