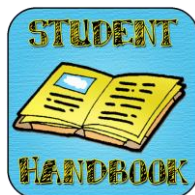

REMINDERS FOR PARENTS

PICTURE MAKE-UP/RETAKE DAY will be Tuesday, November 6.

- ❖ For any student who was absent on Picture Day, an order form and payment will be due.
- ❖ Any student who was not satisfied with his/her portrait may return the original portrait package and have a new photograph taken.



DISMISSAL CHANGES & BUS TRANSFERS:

- Students may only ride their assigned buses.
- Students must get off at their assigned bus stop.
- Parents may not ask the bus driver to adjust their child's bus stop.
- Please do not give your child alternate dismissal instructions, unless the school has been notified in writing and your request has been approved.
- Requests to change a student's permanent bus assignment may be approved by the Principal, or designee, if the request is received in writing a minimum of five days in advance.
- Once a permanent bus change has been approved, students may not switch back to their home bus on days that they are scheduled to go elsewhere.
- Students must be picked up in the car line if they are not taking their assigned bus.
- If there is a family emergency, or medical situation, parents should notify the school Principal and other transportation arrangements may be made.

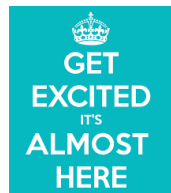

The Chris Herren Story



Chris Herren, a basketball legend from Fall River, Massachusetts, dreamed of one day playing for his hometown team, the Boston Celtics. An All-American, Chris broke scoring records, was recruited by top colleges, featured in *Sports Illustrated* and became the focus of an acclaimed book, *Fall River Dreams*. Herren realized his lifelong dream of playing in the NBA when he was drafted by the Denver Nuggets in 1999 and was traded to the Boston Celtics after his rookie season, but lost it all due to substance abuse.

Alcohol and drug-free since August 1, 2008, he has refocused his life to put his sobriety and family above all else. He shares his harrowing story of abuse and recovery in his memoir, *Basketball Junkie*, as well as in numerous interviews throughout the Emmy nominated ESPN Films documentary *Unguarded*, of which he is the subject.

Please join us for an inspiring presentation featuring former NBA professional basketball player, Chris Herren. A tale of descent into addiction, a miraculous recovery and his new life mission: to share his story with audiences in the hopes of reaching at least one person and making a difference in their life.
