NEW FROM THE NURSE



Daniel Webster Weekly Update - As we continue to celebrate this holiday season please see below for some important highlights to keep you, your family and our school community healthy, safe and ready to learn!



All registered students with Marshfield Public Schools (Including full remote students) are required to have a flu shot or an exemption on file with the school by December 31, 2020 per the state mandate. Please send in, email or fax flu shot documentation/exemptions to the attention of the school nurse. Thank you to everyone who has already sent in documentation.

The current DPH/DESE Guidelines surrounding quarantine have been recently update. Please see below for the main highlights.

The 14-day quarantine recommendation remains in place for any person experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms during the quarantine period, even if they have a negative test, and for those unwilling or unable to conduct active self-monitoring of symptoms.

Under the new guidance, people who have no symptoms and have either a negative PCR **or** antigen test (NOT a rapid test) taken on Day 5 or later, can be released on Day 8 (following 7 days of quarantine).

If the person does not have a test and does not have symptoms, they may be allowed to leave quarantine on Day 11 (following 10 days of quarantine).

Under either option, the individual must conduct active monitoring of their symptoms through Day 14 and get tested and isolate if they develop any sign of disease.

The guidance for a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 has not changed, which means they should stay in self-isolation for 10 days. They can resume public activities after the 10 days as long as they have gone for 24 hours without a fever and without taking fever-reducing medications like Tylenol and have experienced improvement in other symptoms, such as a cough that has gotten much better.

Massachusetts has travel restrictions and recommendations in place to help protect our community members and keep our schools open.
