- \* 2 different color highlighters
- \* 2 sharpened pencils with erasers
- 5 3-hole punched dividers with tabs *labeled*  
Science, Social Studies, Math, ELA & Spelling
- \* 2 red correcting pens
- \* 2 black Dry Erase markers
- 1 pencil pouch or pencil box
- 1 box 24 color crayons (NO larger)
- 1 three-ring binder (2-2 1/2 inches, NO larger) zippered binders are OK
- 1 Spiral notebook with 90+ pages (dividers not needed)
- 1 Plastic three hole punched homework folder with pockets
- 1 set of multiplication flashcards *for home use*
- \* 2 boxes of tissues, 1 container of disinfecting wipes, and 1 container Wet Ones
- \* 1 chapter book for independent reading
  
- \*These items will need to be replenished during the year

**Optional:** A donation of a deck of regular playing cards would be appreciated. These will be placed in a class math game bin for all to use.
