RESPONSE BY SCHOOL AUTHORITIES

Ordinarily, you will receive a response to your proposed plan within twenty-five (25) working days from the date of receipt of your completed application and proposed home education plan. If the Superintendent determines the proposed plan does not meet the provisions of the School Committee Policy for Home Schooling, the Superintendent or his designee will recommend specific changes to be made to improve the plan, and will provide appropriate consultation and/or school resources to assist the parent(s)/ guardian(s).

If the requested changes are not made, or if the revised plan is not approved by the Superintendent, the parent(s)/ guardian(s) have the right to request a hearing directly with the School Committee to present their plan.

If the plan is accepted, parent(s)/ guardian(s), the School Committee, and school personnel agree to abide by the terms of the MPSD Home Schooling Policy.
